Professor Dr YUKIE (KOZO) NIWA

Graduated from the Faculty of Medicine of top Japanese university, Kyoto University, in 1962. He holds a Ph.D. in medicine, and is Director of the Niwa Institute of Immunology.

Dr. Niwa has been involved in clinical research into oxygen radicals and SOD for many years both in Japan and, since the 1970s, internationally.

He is now recognized as a world authority in this field.

He has published more than 70 articles on SOD and other biodefences in prominent English-language international medical journals such as "Blood", and is also on the adjudication panel of papers submitted to the international specialist journal, "Biochemical Pharmacology".

In his own country, he has devoted many years to the treatment of and research into Behcet's disease, rheumatism and atopic dermatitis, identifying abnormalities in free radicals as the cause of these intractable diseases. Adopting a SOD product from Dr. Michelson of France, Dr. Niwa used plants and grains from nature to develop his own low-molecular antioxidants, including SOD-action foods and anti-cancer medicines, and has been extremely successful in the treatment of various diseases with these products.

Dr. Niwa was also a forerunner in the investigation into the change inflicted by infrared rays not only on water, animals and the human body in general, but also their physiological and biochemical changes to the body at the molecular level. He has published a number of papers in this subject in medical journals both in Japan and internationally.
